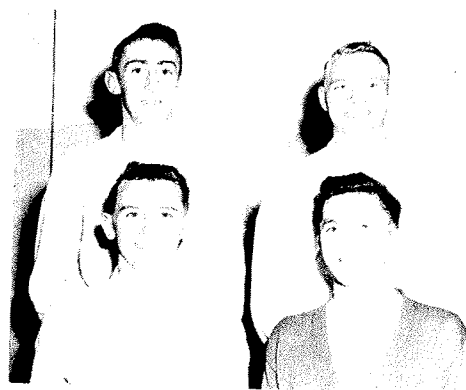

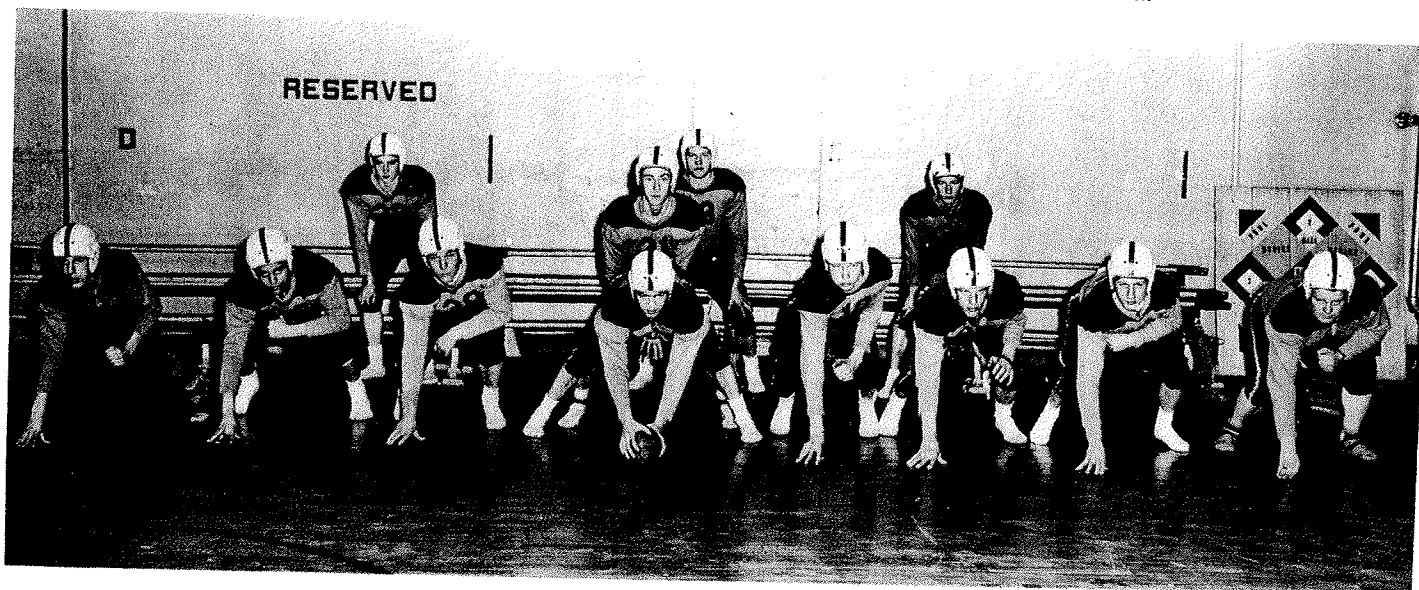

The climax of the football season came when the Bears defeated their arch rivals, the Rice Lake Warriors, 25 to 6 in the annual Homecoming Game.

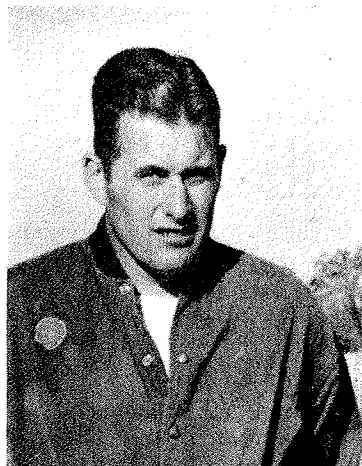

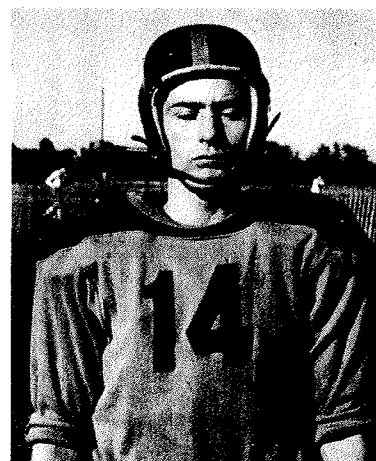

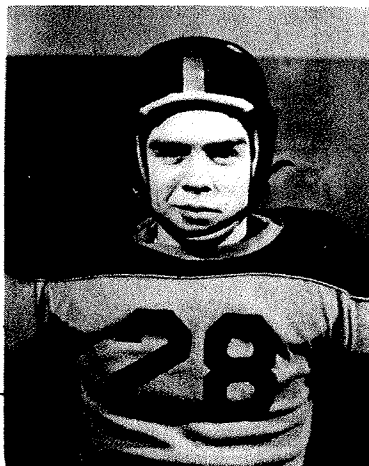
