

Moments Of Glory

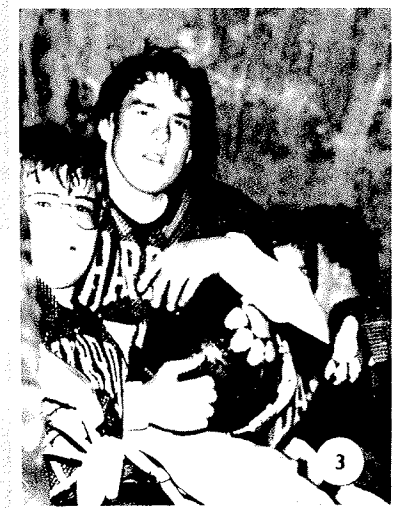
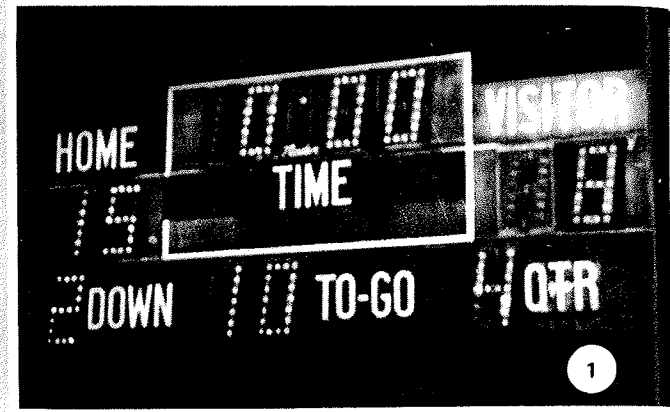

The co-captains who led the victorious Bears this season were Stacy Novinski and Todd Snyder.

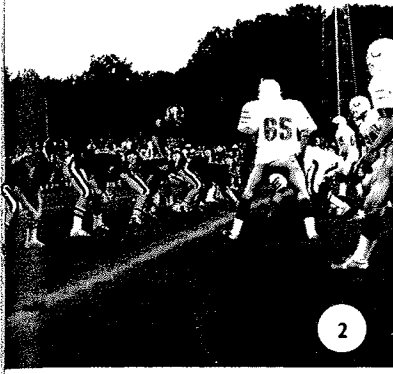

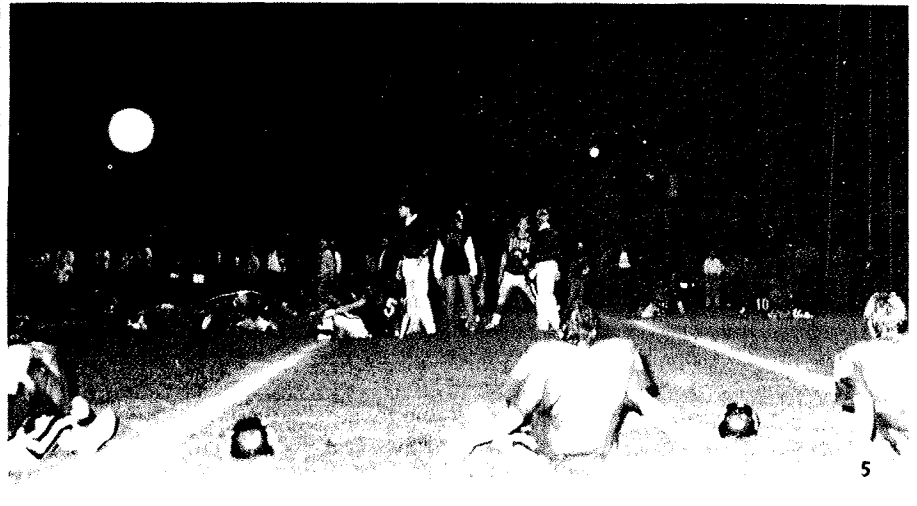
