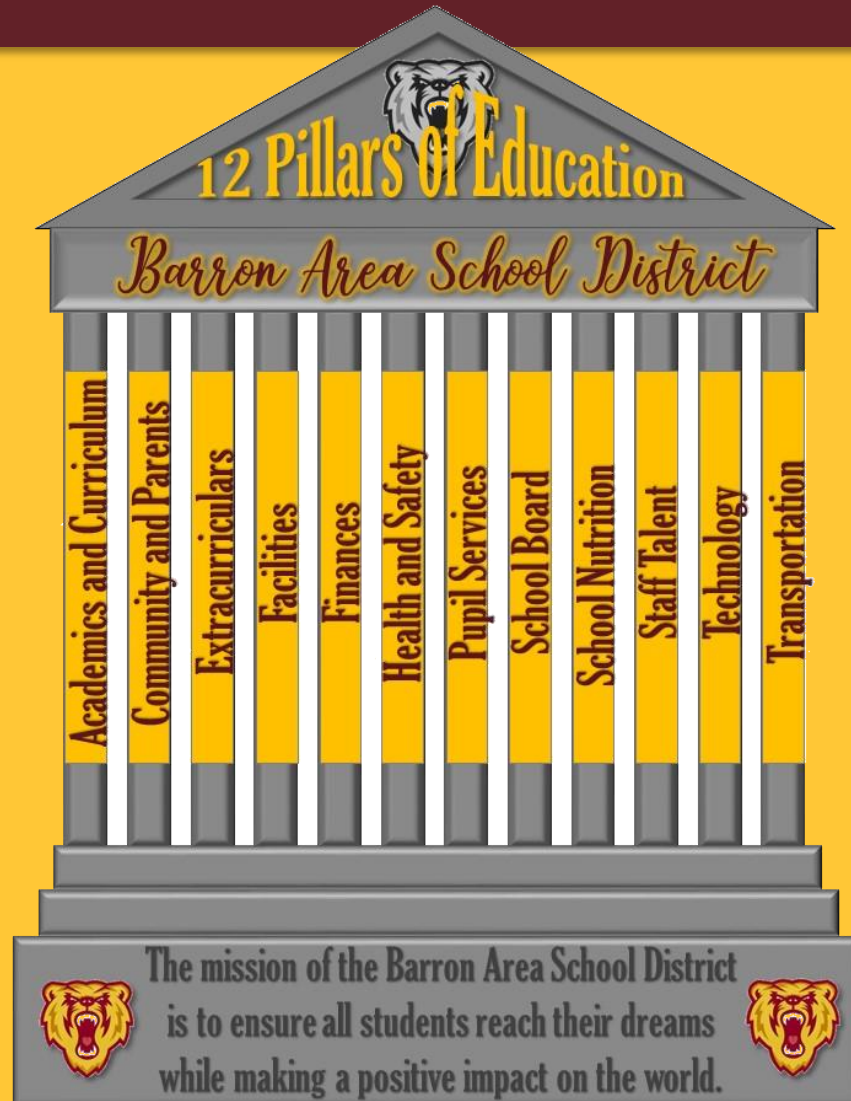

By the end of the 2020-2021 school year,
our district will...

Academics and Curriculum



- Remain meeting or exceeding state expectations with a minimum of 71pts when/if State Report Cards are reported
- 75% of our students will achieve average or above Growth on our annual Star assessments by Spring 2021
- Assess our students to identify gaps that may or may not have occurred during our school shutdown and determine the correct course of education
- Reach a 98% graduation rate for 4 and 6 year cohorts
- Continue defining what career and college ready means in our district

Academics and Curriculum



Continue BASD Curriculum Work:

Align our identified standards with our instruction and develop assessments to support differentiation and mastery of the standards.

- Make new efforts to insure that each student participates in a minimum of one extracurricular activity

- Complete our long-term facilities plans in conjunction with our Finance Goals

Finances



- Review and potentially revise all staff compensation schedules and handbook language, in order to put our best foot forward for our entire staff
- Prioritize financial needs to effectively deal with our COVID pandemic in order to sustain operations
- Begin preparing for Referendum Ballot language for spring 2021 vote

Health and Safety



- Increase participation in our Wellness Program by 10%
- Complete labeling our buildings in accordance with extensions appropriately to prepare for potential emergency authority entry
- Ensure that all staff are ALICE trained and experience two drills which incorporates a solid reunification practice
- Increase awareness and training of staff in recognizing and dealing with health emergencies, including COVID specific awareness

Pupil Services



- Engage our trauma-informed team to determine universal practices K-12 and develop a plan to roll this out
- Increase supports for mental health and social-emotional needs in our schools
- Successfully implement our Elementary Wraparound program to include 6:00 a.m. -6:00 p.m. hours available for families
- Increase our Mentorship program participation by 10%

School Board



- Review our survey from our Community, in order to guide our next steps regarding facilities needs and referendum
- Complete our long-term planning process
- Act effectively and fluidly with processes and procedures during this Worldwide pandemic, in order to best serve our Golden Bears in order to continue meeting our District Mission

School Nutrition



- Promote our School Nutrition program
- Insure that all students have easy access to breakfast, lunches and our backpack program

Staff Talent



- Align staff talent development options with our District and building goals
- Continue horizontal and vertical curriculum conversations in regards to sequential learning and common assessment
- Assess our staff in order to assure that they have adequate training needed to support increasing rigor in classroom instruction and have proper skills to effectively utilize all district platforms and resources

Technology



- Assure that technology is available and ready in preparation for virtual learning and train staff in order to increase their comfort levels and effectiveness of virtual schooling
- Provide continued cyber security training to our staff by measuring understanding using random simulation exercises, evaluation, and communication of best practices emphasizing the critical nature of data security
- Complete implementation of ClassLink software, providing students instant access to their learning resources in one location
