- ✓ Define what career and college ready means in our district

- ✓ Complete new Entry way work
- ✓ Finish plans and prepare for Phase III work at our High School
- ✓ Complete our long-term facilities plans in conjunction with our Finance goals

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Finances



- ✓ Review and potentially revise staff compensation schedules
- ✓ Provide a revamped Cash-in-Lieu of health insurance compensation incentive
- ✓ Efficiently and effectively close out high school building project in conjunction with debt financing timelines
- ✓ Begin preparing for Referendum Ballot language for spring 2021 vote

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Food Services

- ✓ Promote Food Services program
- ✓ Insure that all students have easy access to breakfast, lunches and our backpack program

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Health and Safety



- ✓ Increase participation in our Wellness Program by 10%
- ✓ Label our buildings appropriately to prepare for potential emergency authority entry
- ✓ Ensure that all staff is ALICE trained and experience 2 drills which incorporates a solid reunification practice
- ✓ Increase awareness and training of staff in recognizing and dealing with health emergencies.

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Pupil Services



- ✓ Engage our trauma informed team to determine universal practices K-12 and develop a plan to roll this out
- ✓ Increase supports for mental health and social-emotional needs our schools
- ✓ Increase student involvement by 10% in our 21st Century Community Learning Center
- ✓ Successfully implement our Elementary Wraparound programming
- ✓ Increase our Mentorship program participation to 40

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School Board



- ✓ We will develop a timeline and strategy heading into operational referendum vote spring 2021 for 2022-23 School year
- ✓ Survey our Community Support in order to guide our next steps regarding facilities needs

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Staff Talent



- ✓ Align staff talent development options with our district and building goals
- ✓ Continue horizontal and vertical curriculum conversations in regards to sequential learning and common assessment
- ✓ Assess our staff in order to assure that they have adequate training needed to support increasing rigor in classroom instruction and have proper skills to effectively utilize all district platforms and resources

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Technology



- ✓ Expand users of eduCLIMBER software by providing training/support to grade level teams introducing how to use thresholds to identify, assess, and monitor students for data driven decisions
- ✓ Provide continued cyber security training to our staff by measuring understanding using random simulation exercises, evaluation, and communication of best practices emphasizing the critical nature of data security
- ✓ Implementation of ClassLink software at the elementary schools and middle school for a secure single sign-on solution providing students instant access to their learning resources in one location

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Transportation



- ✓ Begin upgrading camera system to assure safety in our buses
- ✓ Add a new bus and a 10 passenger van to our transportation arsenal
- ✓ Recruit two additional drivers
- ✓ Investigate practices in order to reduce specialized transportation

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
