2020-2021 Supplies and Student Fees



Please bring the supplies listed below to orientation or send with your child the first day of school.

Please send these items to be kept at school:

Label these items with child's name:

- ◇ *A pair of shoes used as indoor shoes (no flip flops or slippers)*
- ◇ *A complete set of clothing: pants, shirt, socks, underwear, a sweatshirt in a zip lock bag*
- ◇ *Brush or comb (optional)*

Do NOT label these items:

- ◇ *A 4x6" family photo to display in the classroom (in a frame if possible)*
- ◇ *A small non-poisonous plant for the children to care for this year*
- ◇ *2 box crackers/dried goods*
- ◇ *1 Box colored pencils*
- ◇ *Stickers (non-character stickers)*
- ◇ *1 pack watercolor paper*
- ◇ *2 boxes of tissues*
- ◇ *1 box gallon Zip-loc bags*

During the school year also send a **Nutritious lunch**, if your child is attending full-day and bringing lunch from home.

Fees can be paid at Welcome Back Day or in the Almena office during the first week of school.

Certain standard fees are paid by all BASD students and are collected at the beginning of each school year:

- Milk fee for snack (approximate price): \$5/Month or \$45/Year
- Lunch: \$2.65/Day
- Breakfast: \$1.25/Day

Montessori specific fees

In the Children's House, practical life activities are used daily and are important for gaining skills necessary for future work in other areas, such as the refinement of fine motor control needed to use a pencil. Most of the practical life activities include food items to be washed, peeled, and cut. To ensure a reliable supply for children to be able to do this important work, we ask that you either:

- Pay \$50 for one child/\$75 for two or more children
- **OR**
- Be willing to provide groceries from a list your child will bring home twice throughout the year

(We are offering this option as a request from parents; some enjoy shopping for the items while others would rather pay a one time fee.)
