When: December 5th 6:30 - 7:45 p.m.

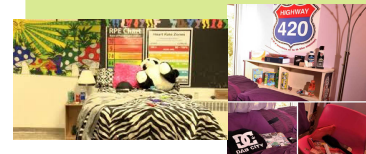
Who: Anyone who would like to attend

Mock Bedroom: "Hands-on" experience!

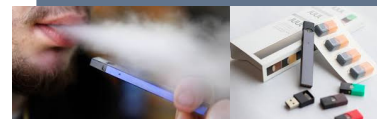
The mock room resembles a teen's room and provides insight and understanding regarding signs of potential substance abuse.
