**If your child is already receiving regular dental care, please disregard this notice.**

Dental health is essential for overall health. It is important that your child have a dental examination every six months to a year. As part of a grade-wide screening program, the school nurse has examined your child's mouth. We recommend that a dentist see your child at this time

Badgercare covers dental costs for children when the dentist accepts the coverage. You can apply for Badgercare by calling the Barron County Human Services at 715- 537-5691.

Remember that healthy teeth make for a healthy child. Make sure your child brushes and flosses regularly, especially at bedtime. Pop is one of the leading causes of dental decay. We recommend that you try to limit or eliminate the use of pop in your home.

Please inform the school nurse at your child's school, once you have made a dental appointment for your child.
