

RIVERVIEW MIDDLE SCHOOL: INCLEMENT WEATHER PLAN

At Home Learning: Riverview Middle School staff did an excellent job of using online platforms such as Google Classroom during the COVID-19 school closure. Therefore, Riverview has the capacity to provide online instruction for a school closure due to an emergency or inclement weather. In the event our district will issue At Home Learning for inclement weather, communication will go out to our staff, students, and families prior to the school closure for planning purposes. Planning for the inclement weather At Home Learning Day can be prepared for when students are still in the building.

Google Classroom: This will be our main platform for communicating curriculum to our students/families. If you need assistance with this, please email your homeroom teacher. If families do not have access to the internet or devices, the teacher will send hard copies of the instructional materials/projects home with students or provide offline work. Teachers will be available from 8-11 am and 1-3:30 pm for questions and support via email. Our main goal is to provide our students engaging curriculum and feedback during the school closure.

Student Attendance: Students will be required to check their school email and log into their homeroom's Google Classroom and confirm their attendance. All students are expected to attend and complete posted assignments. If your child does not login and participate with their online work, the day will be an unexcused absence. Parent/caregiver can contact the school and leave a message if their child will be absent at 715-537-5641.

Student Expectations: Students will check their email and google classroom from their teachers. At home learning assignments will be completed by the date identified by the teacher. Teachers will be available by email from 8-11 am and 1-3:30 pm for questions and support. Be respectful, responsible, and safe while learning online at home and follow your teachers' expectations.

Tech Support: If you need any tech support, please contact your homeroom teacher. **Academic Support:** Use your district email or google classroom to contact the teacher during the designated times. Be patient, as your teacher may be assisting other classmates.
