The foundation was the vision of several local community leaders in 1992. A volunteer board was organized with the first scholarship given in 1992 for \$300. Steady growth through the next 2 decades resulted in a fund now in excess of \$300,000. Approximately 50 scholarships are given out each year to graduating seniors.
