Monday, October 28th

Objective:

Tuesday, October 29th

Objective:

1. Students will summarize what they learned from the reading on Monday.

2. Students will increase vocabulary by defining vocabulary terms.

Activity:

-Class discussion Ancient Rome

-What did you learn from the reading?

-Did you use the scanning technique? Was it helpful?

-Students will choose vocabulary terms from the PowerPoint to define in order to increase reading comprehension

-Differentiation for lower level students: vocabulary words are pre-determined, only write part

of speech and definition.

Wednesday, October 30th

Objective:

1. Read and comprehend The World History Short on Ancient Rome

Activity:

-Students will individually read The World History Short on Ancient Rome

-Differentiation for lower level students: teacher reads to students

-Complete comprehension questions

-Differentiation: complete comprehension questions with a focus on word recognition and

scanning.

-Students are introduced to Ancient Rome Architecture project

-Broken into groups to plan and discuss

Thursday, October, 31st

Objective:

1. Students will use the knowledge gained about ancient Roman architecture through building either the Colosseum or the Pantheon out of marshmallows and toothpicks.

Activity:

-Students work together in small groups to build their own Colosseum or Pantheon out of marshmallows and toothpicks

Friday, November 1st

Objective:

1. Students will explore a current event

2. Students will practice scanning through looking for answer questions

Activity:

-Students complete a "Current Event Friday" worksheet

-Differentiated for level of students
